Build Day Safety Guidelines

If you are exhibiting the following symptoms:

- Fever
- Cough
- Cold
- Headache
- Diarrhea
- Shortness of breath
- Sore throat
- Joint/Muscle Pain

Please leave the premises and contact your physician.

SAFETY GUIDELINES TO FOLLOW

1. Temperature checks at beginning of day.
2. Social Distance minimum 6' when possible.
3. Starting materials stored, exterior storage area:
 - A. Heavy materials, bags, pallets, etc. stored in designated area.
 - B. Heavy materials, bags, pallets, etc. stored in designated area.
 - C. Heavy materials, bags, pallets, etc. stored in designated area.
4. Hand Sanitization Stations available in waste barrels.
 - A. [Hand Sanitization Stations available in waste barrels.]
5. Portable Toilet cleaned and disinfected at beginning of day.
 - A. Users to wipe down toilet after each use.
6. Trash discarded into trash bags and placed in dumpster.
7. Habitat tools will be cleaned at end of build day.

Safety during COVID-19

We are so grateful for our community volunteers who give of their time to help us build. During these days of COVID-19, we have in place our Safety Guidelines including those who volunteer during Build Days.

To ensure the safety of our volunteers, staff and core crew construction members, we have implemented and continue to monitor our safety guidelines.

We ask you to wear face masks, gloves and practicing social distancing while on the build site. Prior to starting the day, you will be asked to complete a COVID-19 questionnaire as well as complete our volunteer waiver form.

Protecting our volunteers is vital to having a safe and fun day.
