Volunteers of all skill levels are welcome and receive guidance from experienced construction leaders throughout the build.

Through volunteer labor, community partnerships, and donor support, Habitat for Humanity continues to create opportunities for local families to build strength, stability, and self-reliance through safe and affordable housing.
